Subject: ECHA/2009/39: Multiple Framework Contract with reopening of competition and division into lots for external service provision for development, studies, support of information systems and security, awarded through an open procurement procedure

CLARIFICATIONS 27

27.1 While filling the project references form (Page 84 of Tender document), is it mandatory to specify client name and contact person or can we submit them upon selection? For ex, if we worked with a large retailer, can we just say that “a large retailer in [country A]” against client name? In some cases we can provide all the details, but in some cases as per our contract with the customers we might not be able to divulge this information at the RFP response stage.

All tenderers are required to specify the name and a contact person of their references.

27.2 On Page 27, in section 2.2.2.1.3, there is a statement “An economic operator may rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. In that case, evidence must be provided that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing a clear undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal”

- a. Is this meant for the subcontractor, for example, for ECHA to consider capacities of subcontractors such as revenues, resource strength etc.. , is this required to be provided?

OR

- b. Is this an evidence required to showcase other relationships outside the subcontractors that are going to be registered for this tender

Such evidence is required in order to be able to carry out a consolidated assessment of the technical, professional, financial and economic capacity of all entities involved in the bid in light of the selection criteria.
