Work Environment description gives a list of technologies which can be used. Is this an intention to enumerate them as a list of technologies already available at ECHA or as constraints?

Diligent analysis of case studies you provided us with shows that we can tremendously improve efficiency and quality of solution by using at least two technologies not currently listed. Therefore we would like to ask if any other (not currently listed) technologies are allowed?

The list of technologies is to be seen as technologies which are readily available in the Case Study scenario. You may propose to introduce technologies which are not listed. In such a case please reflect in your proposal, that they are not readily available but need to be introduced alongside the project itself.
